The Marriage Relationship

- Ordained by God from the beginning
 - Genesis 2:18, 22-24
- Holy and honorable
 - **Hebrews** 13:4
- A picture of God's relationship with His people
 - Ephesians 5:22-33; Hosea 2:19-23
- Marriage is a covenant for life
 - Romans 7:2-3

Responsibilities in Marriage

- Husbands to love their wives
 - Eph. 5:25; 1 Peter 3:7
- Wives are to respect their husbands
 - Eph. 5:33; 1 Peter 3:1-6
- Both are to serve each other
 - 1 Cor. 7:1-4; Phil. 2:3-5
- Both are to help raise children in godliness
 - Eph. 6:4; Prov. 1:8

The Problem of Divorce

- Divorce is breaking the covenant and God hates divorce
 - Mal. 2:14-16
- Divorce is sinful, with only one exception
 - Matt. 5:31-32
 - Matt. 19:1-10

The Divorce Argument

- There is but one cause for divorce (fornication) that allows an innocent party the right to remarriage. However, there are situations in which a person may have to leave a marriage in order to serve the Lord (see Luke 14:26; 18:29).

What About Divorce Without Remarriage?

- What about 1 Corinthians 7:11?
- What is the Law in this passage?
 - Vs. 10 "The wife should not leave"
 - Vs. 11 "The husband should not divorce"
- The option of remaining unmarried in verse
 11 does not justify the act of divorce
 - Vs. 10 and 11 clearly show that the law is that divorce is sinful.

God's Law on Divorce

- Matt. 5:32 "Whoever divorces his wife...makes her commit adultery..."
- Matt. 19:6 "What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate."
- Mark 10:9 "What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate."
- 1 Cor. 7:10 "The wife should not leave her husband."
- 1 Cor. 7:11 "The husband should not divorce his wife."
- 1 Cor. 7:12 "And she consents to live with him, he must not divorce her."
- 1 Cor. 7:13 "She must not send her husband away"
